Columbus back in Chair position at LPRCA

Tillsonburg, Ontario – Norfolk County councillor Mike Columbus has been re-elected as chair for the Long Point Region Conservation Authority (LPRCA). Columbus has seven years experience with the Board, two of which he spent as chair.

John Scholten, a councillor in the Township of Norwich, remains vice-chair.

Both Columbus and Scholten were elected by the LPRCA board of directors at the board meeting on Wednesday, January 10, 2018. Elections are held for both positions at the first board meeting each year.

“I am very pleased to serve again as Chair for the Conservation Authority,” said Columbus. “It is important that initiatives in 2018 continue to help the environment, improve infrastructure and finances.”

Columbus said with the support and cooperation of the LPRCA board there are plans to continue to upgrade campground infrastructure and evaluate water reservoirs and dams. He also identified the importance of the implementation and enhancement of the Backhouse Historic Site Strategic Plan.

The 11-member LPRCA board is composed of representatives appointed by the municipalities within the Long Point Region watershed.
